

If you believe that Jesus died for you, and ask Him to forgive your sin. **He will!** And He will give you the only peace and joy in this life.



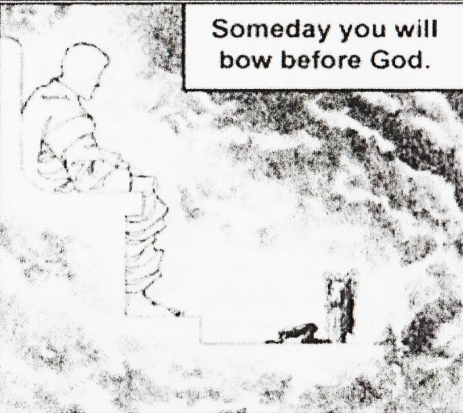
Romans 10:9-10 New Living Translation (NLT)

9 If you openly declare that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. 10 For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by openly declaring your faith that you are saved.

Ephesians 2:8-10 New Living Translation (NLT)

8 God saved you by his grace when you believed. And you can't take credit for this; it is a gift from God. 9 Salvation is not a reward for the good things we have done, so none of us can boast about it. 10 For we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago.

**Jesus Christ was with His Father and the Holy Spirit in the beginning and He created the earth and everything on it.**

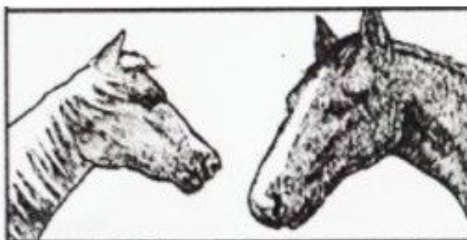
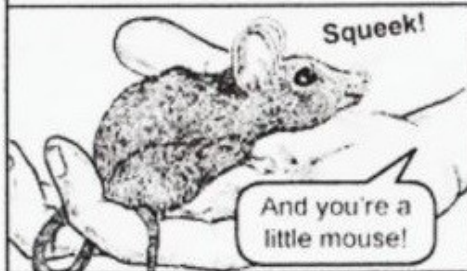

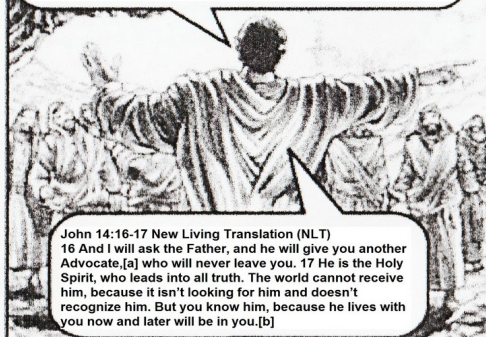
Three days after the Lord was buried, He arose from the dead.

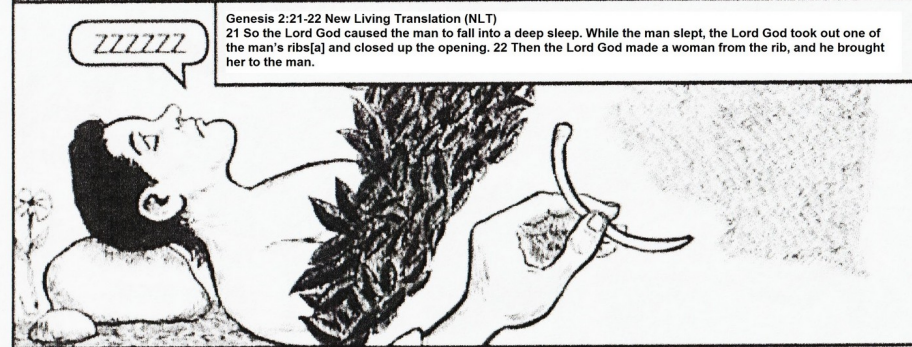


"All that the Father giveth me shall come to me; and him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out."

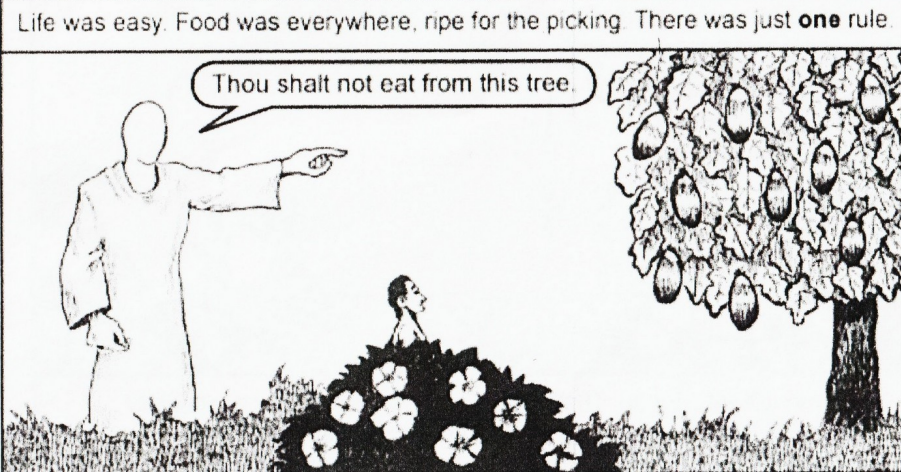
Adam understood the object lesson. Now God went into action.

But the serpent wanted Eve to doubt God.

If you eat it, you'll be like gods! Go ahead...

That does look pretty good... What a dumb rule God made.

So, one day Adam and Eve disobeyed God.

It's delicious, Adam... Take another bite!

Okay... No one will know.

But God did...

Once man disobeyed God and took and ate the fruit of knowledge of good and evil, God could not allow him to remain in His presence and He separated man from Himself by kicking them out of the Garden.

Go!

Because of their sin, man had to live without the presence of God and the blessings that He created for them. They forfeited their rule over the world's creation and lost their eternity. They then had to contend with the harshness of the earth outside of the garden and they had to suffer in hardship for the remaining days of their lives just as we do.

Jesus, God's Son, shed His precious blood on the cross when He died to take our punishment for our sins.

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life" John 3:16

He died, was buried, and rose again three days later. He paid the price, and gave us the way back to God.

Jesus shed His blood so every sin ever committed could be forgiven.

"...without shedding of blood (there) is no remission (for sins)."\*

Medical view of His suffering by G. Bradley, M.D.

This was the most agonizing death man could face... He had to support Himself in order to breathe... The flaming pain of the spikes hitting the median nerve in the wrists explodes up His arms, into His brain and down His spine.

The spike burning through the nerves of the feet jerks His body erect, then the leg muscles convulse and drive His body downward... beating Him against the cross. Exhaustion, shock, dehydration and paralysis destroy the victim.

Just before He died, Jesus shouted...  
"IT IS FINISHED!"

The penalty for the sins of all mankind had been paid in full.

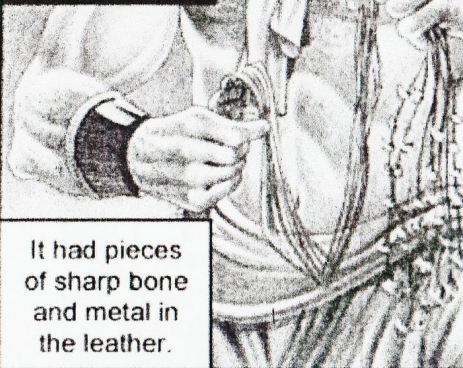
Now *anyone* could be saved by putting their faith in Jesus Christ.

Jesus was scourged with a special whip.



It had pieces of sharp bone and metal in the leather.

He was stripped, and His hands were tied to an overhead beam.



The whip tore away flesh, spurring blood. Muscles were sliced wide open.

**Most victims died from the beating.**

They mocked Him with a purple robe and a crown of thorns.



He was beaten and led away to be crucified.

With His flesh in ribbons, He carried a 100 pound cross 650 yards to the place of execution.



I got part of His beard.

**KILL HIM!**

The rough wood gouged His torn, dehydrated body. **Only a miracle kept Him alive!**

Then He was forced to die on a cross. But this was God's plan!



"For God sent not his son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through him might be saved." John 3:17

God told us from the beginning that the punishment for sin is death.

Genesis 2:16-17 New Living Translation (NLT)

16 But the Lord God warned him, "You may freely eat the fruit of every tree in the garden— 17 except the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. If you eat its fruit, you are sure to die."

Ezekiel 3:18 New Living Translation (NLT)

18 If I warn the wicked, saying, 'You are under the penalty of death,' but you fail to deliver the warning, they will die in their sins. And I will hold you responsible for their deaths.



Romans 6:23 New Living Translation (NLT)

23 For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord.

God still loved us and made a way for us to get back together with Him. He sent His only begotten Son to become a man and live a perfect life.



Then God's Son did the unthinkable:

Jesus' ministry began at age 30. John the Baptist introduced Him...

Behold, the **Lamb of God**, which taketh away the sin of the world.

John meant that on a future passover the Lord Jesus would be sacrificed to pay the terrible price for the sins of all men.

**This was His purpose in coming from heaven.**



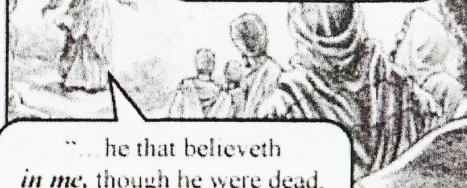
He shocked the religious community by opening blind eyes, deaf ears... and healing lepers. **He even raised the dead!** (See Matt. 8 & 9)

"This do in remembrance of me."\*

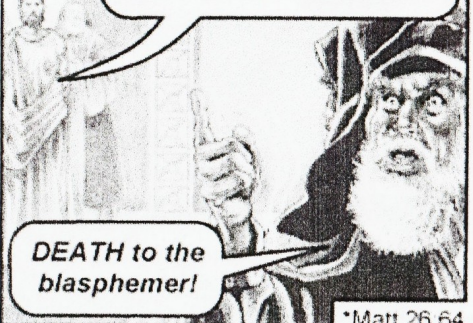


\*Luke 22:19

\*Matt 26:64

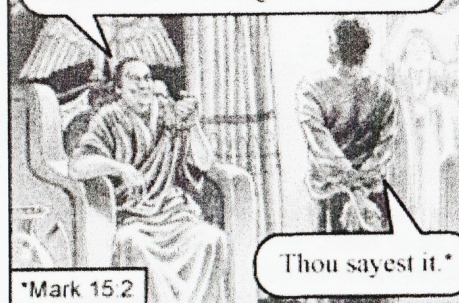
When sentenced to death, the angels of God watched in horror.

Pilate tried to reason with the blood-thirsty mob.

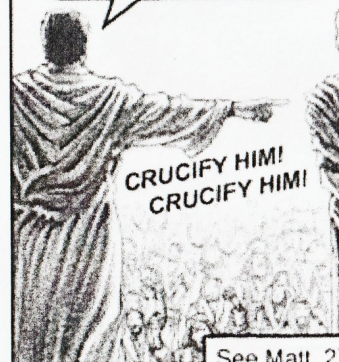

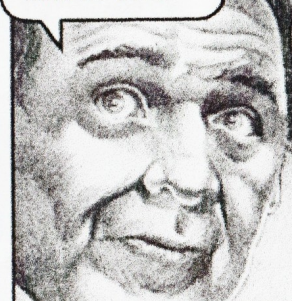

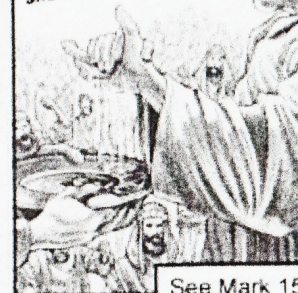
